Single vineyard pinot noir from the Queensberry sub-region of Central Otago. A charming wine with tones of red cherry, strawberry and raspberry coulis cut with hints of wood spice, dried smoked meats, pressed flowers, wild thyme and earth. There is a spacious, savoury feel to the palate's shape, with plenty of fine, structural detail and energy. Finishes medium-weighted with spice, raspberry and strawberry on the exit.

Lots of black cherries and black licorice with stone and slate on the nose. Medium-bodied, this has crunchy, chewy fruit and a flavorful finish. Structured with polished tannins. Persistent at the end. Drink or hold.
