Rich, weighty chardonnay that nicely balances fruit and alcohol sweetness against gently tangy acidity. The result is a deliciously accessible wine that offers good drinking now but promises to develop well with bottle age

Such an inviting wine with its aromas of struck flint, lemon verbena and white peach with underlying hints of soft spice, apple pastries, French oak, lemon curd, almond meal and wisps of struck match complexity. There's some lovely textural elements on the palate, all slinky and sleek with umami notes, a crisp, briny mineral drivetrain and great length of flavour.
